**Rounds:** Double New National, Long National, and National; and National 50, 40, and 30 according to age of juniors.  
**Judges:** Brian Dunlop, Katy Lipscomb, and Pat Kerrigan. **Lady Paramount:** TBA

**Assembly:** 9.30 a.m. **Equipment inspection:** 30 minutes before assembly. **Sighters:** after assembly and before afternoon session.

**Kestrels Awards:** Trophies and medals for **double** rounds only and depending upon number of entries. (UK records available on both **single** rounds.)

**Richard Steele Memorial Shield** for highest scoring longbow archer in any double round.

**Mixed Team Challenge** – 4 archers from same club, must include: 1 adult, 1 junior, 1 male, 1 female, 1 compound, 1 recurve, 1 longbow or barebow.

**Laburnam Trophy** for barebow team - 3 archers from same club.

By entering this tournament competitors agree to their results, as defined in the Archery GB Shooting Administration Procedures (SAP), being published by Kestrels AC and passed to affiliated archery organisations, for example Archery GB.

In line with the provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs or digital images at the event will need to register with the Tournament Organiser (TO) on the day.
